Northland School Board of Trustees and Management will identify strategies for continuous improvement, which ensure that quality learning and teaching takes place.

The school is committed to equitable policies and practices for students and staff, and values equity of opportunities for all students.

Northland School Board of Trustees, Management and Staff will implement the National Education and National Administration Guidelines through:

- policies (which are reviewed on a regular cycle)
- the Northland school curriculum
- the school assessment programme including National Standards.
- Staff Professional Development.
- Performance management and appraisal procedures including teaching as inquiry and evaluation and analysis of Student Achievement.
- reporting to parents on individual achievement
- reporting to the Ministry of Education on school wide achievement including Maori and Pasifika students.
- the Charter and Strategic Plan. The school charter is updated annually and sent to the Ministry.
- an Analysis of Variance between the school's performance and the relevant aims, objectives, directions, priorities or targets set out in the school charter. This is sent to the Ministry of Education.

The school will maintain an ongoing programme of self-review in relation to its policies, plans and programmes and, as part of this, will actively engage with parents, whanau, staff and the community.
