

Learning this term in Team One

Topic - Friendship

We are beginning the term with a topic based on friendships within the class. Part of the theme of the topic is "Bucket filling" which children and their families will become familiar with. You will be sent a letter with further information and home based activities around friendship in the coming weeks.

Alongside our friendship topic is another one, <u>Journeys through picture books</u>. In this topic we will be looking at physical and emotional journeys as well as settings, character and plots within stories. Our Journeys topic is part of a whole school theme. Each Team is looking at Journeys from a different perspective.

Mathematics

In Mathematics we focus daily on building up Number knowledge and strategies. As well as focussing on strengthening Number knowledge and strategies, this term we will be extending our vocabulary when looking at positional language (left, right, quarter turns, half turns). We are also learning to tell the time. Both the positional language and time telling topics sit alongside learning about fractions.

Reporting to Parents

Our transition to reporting about student progress around the time of their 20 week (half year), 40 week (full year), 60 week (year and a half) and 80 week (two year) times at school is well under way. We will set up meeting times with parents around those benchmark times.

We are ready for a wonderful term of learning!
